

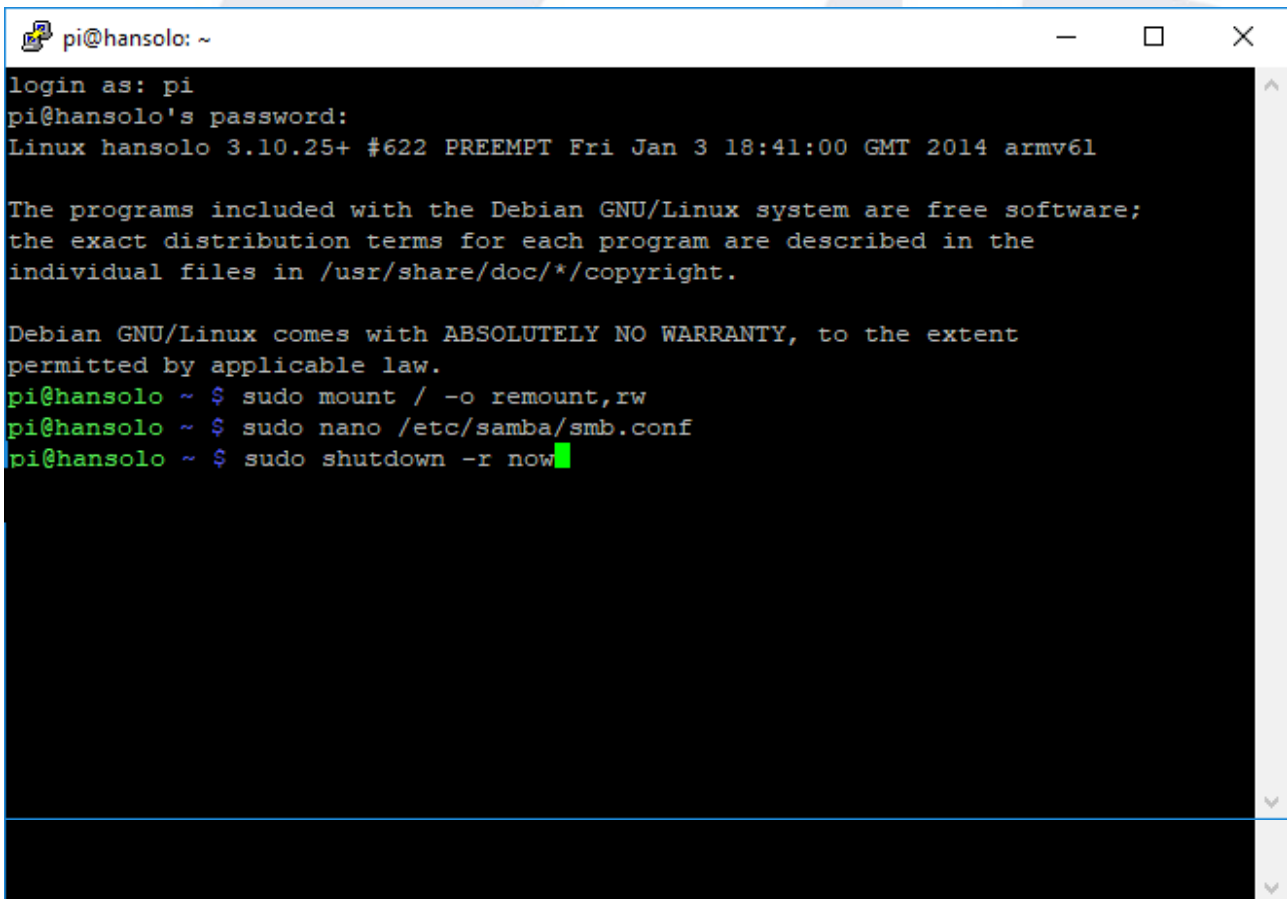
SOLO'S NETWORK FOLDER VISIBILITY

With a recent update to Windows 10 from Microsoft, the SMB1 network protocol the Solo was using has disappeared.

This may lead to issues connecting to the Solo shared folder, in some cases, and while the fix will be included in the next update, having just released a version, here's a quick solution:

- a) connect via ssh to your Solo (usually using "putty")
- b) mount the card read-write so changes can be made and edit the file

- c) modify (just add protocol = SMB2, as in the image, in the [global] section) , then press ctrl-X, and save when asked

d) reboot and you're done - better said you'll be done when windows is also rebooted.
